Dear Parents

Last Saturday a special working Bee was held to 'plant' a memorial garden for students and staff who had have died while at Henschke. Michael Jones had long held as an idea for addition for such a garden to our school and earlier in the year, some ex-students approached Michael to see if they could help do this.

The students lost a classmate 15 years ago. Laura Pulver was about to go into Year 3 in 1999, when she suffered a fatal asthma attack during the Christmas holidays that year. She was the twin sister of Brad, and had older siblings, Matt and Jess at Henschke at that time. Laura was a beautiful little girl who also had the extra challenge of being born with Spina Bifida. She cheerfully coped with this and endeared herself to so many in the short time she was with us. At the time, a beautiful ceremony was held and a garden established just near the old Year 3 demountable classrooms. With all the building changes over the years, that little garden disappeared and remnants of it were placed in the 'Respect' garden.

Classmates of Laura's asked Michael if it would be alright to re-do the garden. So with the very generous help of the Board and over 25 ex-students from that year, the decision to establish a memorial garden near the Tuck shop was made.

The Pulver family were so touched to think that those little Year 3 children of 1999 and the school community, still remember and think of Laura, and it was a beautiful example of what we as a school strive to do. It was great to see them 'serving one another in love' all those years down the track.

Later in the year another tree will be added to the garden to honour the memory of Florence Nickle a much valued member of staff who died in October 2008.

Many thanks to the wonderful support from the Board, Bunnings, those wonderful ex-students and the school community.

We hope that this garden will long be a place of quiet reflection and peace and a living example of our school motto in action.
